How to download your online Universal Credit statements

- 1. Log in to your Universal Credit account: <u>Sign in to your Universal Credit account-</u><u>Universal Credit (universal-credit.service.gov.uk)</u>
- 2. Go to the 'payments' section.
- 3. You should see a list of months in which you have received Universal Credit. Click on one of these to view your statement.
- 4. Click on 'print this statement' usually found in the top right-hand corner of the statement.

Can't click 'Print this statement'? You may need to use a different web browser app. E.g. Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, Safari, Samsung Internet.
